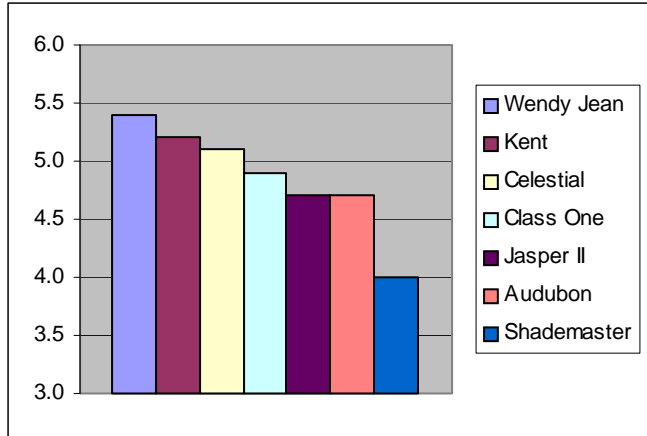

### CHARACTERISTICS

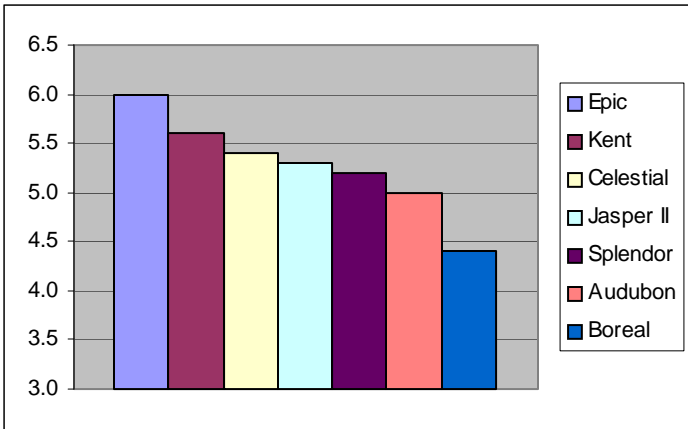
**Kent** strong creeping red fescue is an advanced fine fescue that has shown to have improved disease resistance along with improved density during the growing season. **Kent** strong creeping red fescue also has enhanced early spring green up compared to older varieties.

**Kent** strong creeping red fescue performs very well in low mow/low maintenance situations where drought tolerance is needed and has above average resistance to diseases like melting out, red thread and dollar spot.
