Lexington is a member of the newest generation of traditional style turf type tall fescue. The color and overall turf quality are so outstanding that **Lexington** may be seeded alone.

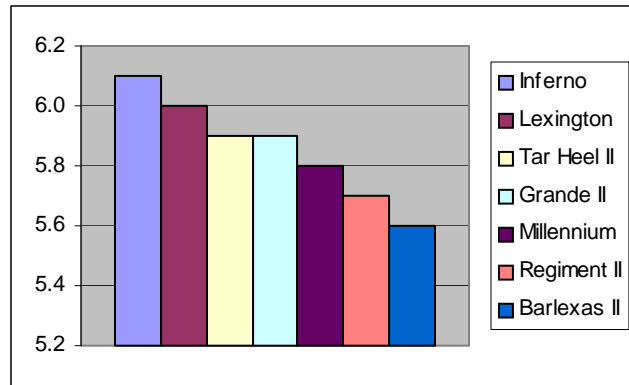
Lexington ability to resist brown patch makes it a wonderful component for a three-way turf type tall fescue blend, or part of bluegrass and perennial ryegrass mixtures.

Lexington adapts well to the transitional zone, the Northeast and the Northwest summer-time conditions. It will grow well in most soils and responds well to water and fertilizer applications.

Lexington has performed extremely well in the current NTEP trials. It is a top performer in genetic color, spring green-up and overall quality.
