CHARACTERISTICS

Verano is an outstanding late tetraploid perennial ryegrass. It is inscribed on the National List in France.

Verano shows good rust resistance and achieves high yields, especially for total dry matter yield and for the late cuts in summer and autumn. Verano achieves these very positive results not only in the first year, but due to its good persistence, a high dry matter yield and good rust resistance can be expected the following years.

Verano is a late maturing tetraploid with a relative heading date of June 14th.
